Program Goal:

The goal of the Catholic Citizenship Essay Contest is to give students an opportunity to define the role of a Catholic citizen in many different scenarios, and to strengthen the bond between the Knights of Columbus and local schools.

Eligibility:

The Catholic Citizenship Essay Contest is open to all Catholic students in grades 8 to 12 during the 2023-24 school year.

2023 - 2024 Catholic Citizenship Essay Contest Theme:

Pope St. Paul VI wrote: "The task of evangelizing all people constitutes the essential mission of the Church."

In an essay of 500-750 words, How can the Church evangelize in the digital age?

In Biblical times, the only way to "carry" good news was to bring it physically, walking from one place to another. Technological advances, however, have opened up numerous additional communication channels, all of which we can use to amplify the rate at which we spread the Word. – Romans 10:14-15

Guidelines:

Essay must reflect the assigned theme and be the student's **<u>original</u>** work.

Content specification: 500-750 words, typed in double spacing, using font "Times New Roman" font size "12", printed single side on a white sheet of paper A4 (8.5' x 11') size. Please submit $\underline{3}$ copies, stapled individually, of the essay.

The student's name should appear on the official Catholic Citizenship Essay entry form provided by the Knights of Columbus, which must be stapled to one of the essays and in an envelope (do not fold the printed essay).

All entries become the property of the Knights of Columbus and will not be returned.

JUDGING

A **100-point scoring system** will be used to determine the winner.

35 Points: Content — How thoroughly is the topic examined?

30 Points: Grammar — How well is the essay written with respect to sentence and paragraph construction?

35 Points: Style — Does the essay show creativity, imagination and development of the topic in a logical and compelling style?
